

# Pack 303 Uniforms

## Official Uniform Patch Placement

Only certain things belong on your tan or blue uniform shirt! Check your rank book or attached inspection sheet for more details. But briefly, it is the following items:

### Right sleeve:

US Flag  
Den Numeral  
Quality Unit Award  
Webelos colors

### Left sleeve:

Viking Council emblem  
Pack number

### Right pocket:

Temporary patch location --  
you can wear only one  
Progress towards Rank or  
Webelos Compass  
Recruiter strip (under pocket)  
Tiger strip (under pocket)  
Summertime award pin  
(centered on flap)

### Left pocket:

Up to 5 Activity Metals, including Service Star (above pocket)  
Bobcat, Bear, Tiger, Wolf patches (starting at noon,  
clockwise), Webelos patch  
Gold and Silver arrow points or Arrow of Light (below pocket)  
Religious & other knots (above pocket)

## Other Uniform Pieces

Our pack wears neckerchiefs, slides and belts specific to each rank. Tigers wear an orange neckerchief, Tiger slide and Tiger belt. Wolf scouts wear a gold neckerchief, Cub Scout slide and Cub Scout belt. The Bear scouts wear a light blue neckerchief, Cub Scout slide and Cub Scout belt. The Webelos wear a multi-colored neckerchief, Webelos slide and Webelos belt.

Other scout clothing is optional. These include the official trousers, socks and caps.

## Red Patch Brag Vests

These red vests are being provided to you by the pack and several enthusiastic sewing volunteers. Please thank Corrina Phillips, Ann Aas, Laurel Schnabel, Tondi Schoepp, Kathy Olmsted and Mary Severson next time you see them.

This vest is for all the patches that your son has collected that are not part of the official Cub Scout uniform. This includes things like Day Camp, Arbor Day or 4th of July patches, and Academics and Sports pins.

Good Turn for America patch goes on the red vest. The 2004 strip goes below the "For".
