Fix It

- Put toolbox together; Show safety of 3 tools
- Help adult with following:
 - Locate electrical panel, fuses or breakers
 - Type of heat used in home
 - Learn how to shut off water sink, toilet, etc.
- Describe fixing:
 - toilet overflowing
 - kitchen sink is clogged
 - some lights go out
 - Change light & dispose bulb
 - Fix squeaky door or cabinet hinge
 - Tighten loose handle/knob
 - Demonstrate stopping a running toilet
 - Replace furnace filter
 - Wash a car
 - Check oil level & tire pressure in car
 - Replace a bulb in a car
 - Change a car tire
 - Repair bicycle, chain, tires, flat, etc
 - Replace wheels on skateboard, scooter, or skat
- Help prepare and paint a room
- Help replace wall or floor tile
- Help repair window/door lock
- Help fix slow or clogged sink
- Help repair a mailbox
- Change battery in smoke or CO2 detector
- Help fix leaky faucet
- Find wall studs & hang curtain rod
- Rebuild/refinish old furniture/toy
- Do project agreed upon with parent

 - Create vid of wild creature & share w/den

- Visit nature center

- List of household things made of wood

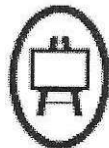

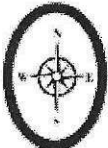

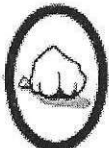
